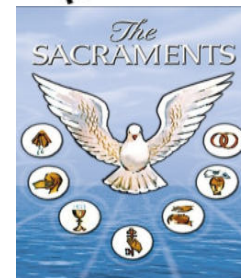




The struggle of faith

Couples need to do a lot more to bring their love to that pitch. Every home is a Domestic Church, a sacred place. Every parish is the living Body of Christ. We have a lot of change to work on.




Christ makes us his disciples

Statue of Our Lady of Mercy

For many years the white statue of Our Lady was permanently situated in the old sacristy. It was clear that the statue was originally coloured and gilded but had been painted white beyond memory. The left hand was broken off but thankfully we still had it.

It was generally believed that the statue was as old as the church.
It was certainly of that period.

The present statue on Our Lady's Altar is of Our Lady of Lourdes and carved in Carrara marble. (The same marble used in the Pieta by Michelangelo), it is certainly a modern addition being more recent than Our Lady's Altar itself.

It is believed that the white sacristy statue adorned
Our Lady's Altar initially.

The statue has recently been fully restored, coloured and gilded by Monica Lyddle who also restored the Stations of the Cross. It has been placed in the coloured window arch at the back of the Church. *We ask Our Lady's protection on this and future generations of our Parish.*

He welcomes sinners

“This man”, the scribes complained, “welcomes sinners and eats with them”. One of the lovely features of the Gospels is the number of meals Jesus shares with people, culminating in the Last Supper with his disciples. When we think of a meal we immediately focus on food. For Jesus in his time the main focus was on the people with whom he shared food, as a meal was a sign of friendship and a pledge of friendship. No one was excluded from this sign. This was a source of scandal to the good people when they saw him eating with sinners. But his message is loud and clear – he is there for everyone. One of the major challenges for us today is to restore this sense of the meal as an occasion to constantly renew our relationships, especially in our families. The regular family meal will do more to unite us than any other action we can take as it helps us to include each other in our lives.

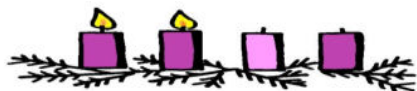
Prepare a way for the Lord

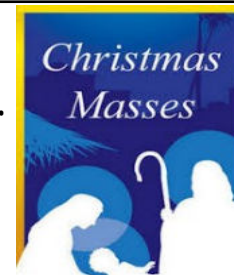

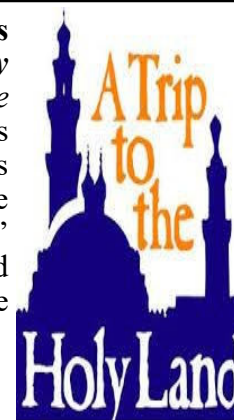
